Day 1 Friday 23rd October Dubbo - Blue Mountains - Sydney

Depart from Dubbo for travel to Sydney via the Blue Mountains. Visit the Scenic Railway, Skyway and Three Sisters at Echo Point. Lunch in the Blue Mountains (own expense), arriving at North Sydney Harbourview Hotel late afternoon. Dinner tonight onboard a Captain Cook Sunset Dinner Cruise.

Day 2 Saturday 24th October Sydney City Sights

A full day Sydney city sights starting with the Northern Beaches including Dee Why, Curl Curl and to Manly for morning tea with a chance to stroll through the Corso. We then head to Taronga Zoo for 2 hours, **just break out and eat like an animal at the Zoo** for lunch (own expense) before heading back toward the city where we start touring the south side of the harbour. Firstly we tour the inner city then to probably one of the best views of the Opera House with the Harbour Bridge in the background. Next we head through Kings Cross, Darling Point, Double Bay, Rose Bay and to Vaucluse to visit the home of William Charles Wentworth (Father of the Constitution) "Vaucluse House" for afternoon tea and a tour. Next we visit Watsons Bay, Dover Heights and Bondi Beach before heading back to our Hotel for dinner.

(D) Day 3 Sunday 25th October Sydney - Wollongong - Sydney

Depart motel after breakfast and travel via the Sydney Harbour Tunnel and along Cliff Drive which is built out over the water alongside the cliff face then through the Royal National Park to Wollongong for a city tour and a visit to Nan Tien Temple including lunch. Travel to Sydney's Darling Harbour and for some free time with the opportunity to visit the Aquarium or Power House Museum or Maritime Museum own expense or just stroll and shop. China Town for dinner tonight included.

Day 4 Monday 26th October Sydney - Mt Tomah - Dubbo

We head westward over Bellbird Hill to Mt Tomah Gardens, high in the Blue Mountains for a garden inspection and an early lunch before boarding the rail motor at the Zig Zag Railway. Afternoon tea at Bathurst before returning to Dubbo.
