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Day 1: Tuesday 20 June 2023 D

Dubbo ~ Sydney ~ Cairns

Departing Dubbo this morning, we fly to Sydney and then straight onto Cairns where we will spend the evening together.

Day 2: Wednesday 21 June 2023 BLD

Cairns ~ Horn Island ~ Thursday Island

Flights have been arranged to take you from Cairns to Cape York this morning. Upon arrival at Horn Island an eXpedition10 crew member will meet you at the airport to escort you on your Cape York adventure. Board the islands bus for a very informative heritage tour of Horn Island - including lunch, visiting many of the sites occupied by Australian and USA troops during WWII. A short ferry ride will take you to Thursday Island to your accommodation.

Day 3: Thursday 22 June 2023 BD

Thursday Island ~ Loyalty Beach

A tour of Thursday Island will point sights such as Battery Point Fort and the cemetery where many pearl divers from around Asia are laid to rest. Visit local artist, Rosie Ware's studio. Rosie has works on display at the National Gallery and National Museum of Australia. While on Thursday Island don't miss the opportunity to have a beer or lunch at the most northern pub in Australia. There will be time to visit the Thursday Island Cultural Centre prior to boarding the ferry for a one-hour trip to the mainland. Loyalty Beach lays on the western shore of Cape York and is known for its excellent sunset views and our home for two nights.

Day 4: Friday 23 June 2023 BLD

eXploring Cape York

Many northern areas of Australia were subject to bombing raids during WWII and there are still several relics lying in the area. Today's adventure will visit some plane wrecks and an old radar station before heading closer to the most northern point on mainland Australia. Call in to the Croc Tent owned by Terry and Davida - a famous souvenir shop which 'appeared' in 1984, then to Somerset where, tides permitting we will take you for a drive on the eastern Cape beaches and finally, the moment you have been waiting for, a visit to The Tip. Upon returning to the bus, enjoy a beach-side bbq dinner while watching the sun set at Cape York.

Day 5: Saturday 24 June 2023 BLD

Loyalty Beach ~ Eliot Falls

South of Loyalty Beach is the Jardine River, a once formidable barrier for visitors to Cape York. Crossing the river has destroyed many vehicles however, in more recent times a vehicular ferry has been introduced making the crossing very easy. While camp is being prepared for tonight, enjoy a refreshing swim in the waters of Eliot Falls. Tonight, we will be camping at Eliot Falls - eXpedition10 style in roomy tents with comfy beds complete with linen and doonas.

Day 6: Sunday 25 June 2023 BLD

Eliot Falls ~ Bramwell Station

The 'best' route from Cape York for many 4X4 enthusiasts, is not the original road. The original track was built to install and service

the old overland telegraph line. This track is known as the Old Telegraph Track. Many still use this old road which has some very difficult creek crossings. A lot of 4X4's make it through to the end of the journey but some don't! Today, road conditions favourable, we will take you to a portion of the Old Telegraph Track to see challenging creek crossings. Before travelling to Bramwell Station for the night.

You may notice that the termite mounds have grown quite tall in this region. Tonight, during dinner, enjoy the entertainment and company of other travellers to Cape York.

Day 7: Monday 26 June 2023 BD

Bramwell Station ~ Weipa

From Bramwell Station, travel through Batavia Downs to the West coast to the bauxite mining centre of Weipa. There will be time for some shopping and lunch in town prior to checking into our accommodation. This evening, board the boat for a wildlife sunset cruise. Cruise the tranquil waters of the Embley River into the golden glow of a sunset, whilst enjoying a cold drink and canapes, your informative guide will point out crocodiles and birds along the way.

Day 8: Tuesday 27 June 2023 BLD

Weipa ~ Portland Road ~ The Temple

Pretty much directly east of Weipa on the eastern side of Cape York is the Lockhart River Region - today's destination. The start of the journey will travel through bauxite mines then cattle stations before meeting up with the main road from Cairns to Seisia. From here into Lockhart River crosses two major Cape York rivers, The Wenlock River and the Pascoe River. Road conditions can vary but the destination makes the journey well worthwhile. Accommodation tonight is nestled atop the hill above Portland Road at "The Temple" converted WWII bunkers converted into luxury accommodation. From up here look for stingray and dugong in the ocean and in the forest for Palm Cockatoo, commonly sighted in the Lockhart area.

Day 9: Wednesday 28 June 2023 BLD

The Temple ~ Lockhart River

Some of today's sightseeing includes; Lockhart River, a small indigenous town famous for artwork created by the Lockhart River Art Gang; Portland Roads, a quiet township comprised of a few houses which was once a vital base in the Battle of the Coral Sea; Chillie Beach, renowned for its palm-fringed beaches and clear blue water. You also have the chance to enjoy an optional helicopter flight (own cost) along the coastline with possible sightings of crocodiles, sharks, turtles and dugongs.

Day 10: Thursday 29 June 2023

The Temple ~ Coen

The journey today will take you back to the Peninsula Developmental Road (PDR) and on to Archer River. At lunchtime we will take a break at the Archer River Roadhouse where you may want to take on the challenge of dining on one of their iconic burgers. Also, make sure to look out for the memorial built to honour Toots Holzheimer. "Toots" was one of Australia's best-known truckies. Toots and her truck were a lifeline for communities the length of Cape York. A little further south is the old gold mining town, Coen. Coen is also home tonight. A visit to the local hotel may have some wondering how it got such an unusual name....

Day 11: Friday 30 June 2023

BLD

Coen ~ Palmerville Station

Detouring from the PDR today will take this journey onto Palmerville Station, a working cattle property. Visit the state-of-the-art cattle yards and enjoy a warm welcome and the friendly hospitality of the hard working station workers. As station life is hard work and often requires workers to be called at short notice to tend to urgent station matters some inclusions planned today may need to be rearranged but either way, we will certainly experience first hand what it's like living on an outback cattle station.

Day 12: Saturday 1 July 2023

BLD

Palmerville Station ~ Cannibal Creek Goldfields

Palmerville is well known for its golden history. Call in to what remains of the old gold town of Maytown then continue on to Cannibal Creek Goldfields. Sitting around the fire tonight join in the conversation with some of the many prospectors using this place as a base to find their fortune. Rest up tonight as tomorrow it will be your turn to join them.

Day 13: Sunday 2 July 2023

BLD

Cannibal Creek Goldfields

We have arranged for expert gold prospectors today to take you to the best places to discover gold. It is not guaranteed that everyone will find gold but, in this location, and with our expert guides you will have the best possible chance. Be warned, gold prospecting is highly addictive and may leave those who participate longing to purchase high quality gold detectors (Smiley Face)
PLEASE NOTE: Prospecting is done through unprepared natural country which has no pathways and could cover some quite rugged country, therefore it is mandatory that you wear long pants, preferably jeans, a wide brimmed hat and closed in shoes.

Day 14: Monday 3 July 2023

Cannibal Creek Goldfields ~ Cooktown

It is a quite beautiful drive through rolling hills and crossing many creeks on the return to the main road from Cannibal Creek Goldfields. Call in to Lakeland to an eXpedition10 eXclusive property for a guided tour by the owner Peter. Peter has lived on and owned cattle properties throughout the Cape York region for many years. His property in Lakeland lies on some incredible

country ranging from grassy paddocks to mountainous bushland. The 'crown jewel' is a massive dam he recently completed to supply water for his stock and irrigation to local banana plantations. Continuing on, take a short drive to Cooktown arriving around lunch time. Following a look around town, check in to your motel for the night.

Day 15: Tuesday 4 July 2023

BLD

Cooktown ~ Daintree

Following some sightseeing in Cooktown this morning our route follows closely to the coastline. Not far south of Cooktown, near Black Mountain, call into the Lions Den Hotel for a lunch break. The Lions Den Hotel was established in 1875 and is still going strong today and is a popular stopping point for travellers on the Bloomfield Track. Near Bloomfield, a short drive will take you into Wujal Wujal Falls, a beautiful place with great cultural significance to the Yalanji people. The track from Wujal Wujal becomes more challenging with steep climbs and descents, many creek crossings and thick rainforests and leads to Cape Tribulation. There will be time in Cape Tribulation to wander along the beach and maybe even have a close encounter with one of the local cassowaries. Continue to Thornton Beach and your last nights accommodation on this tour in the heart of a pristine world heritage rainforest.

Day 16: Wednesday 5 July 2023

Daintree Rainforest ~ Cairns

This morning, a guided rainforest walk has been arranged with local guide. Keep watch for the ever elusive cassowary. Our walk is followed by a wildlife discovery cruise. These two tours are certainly the best way to appreciate this remarkable rainforest and showcase unique biological diversity and exceptional rainforest integrity. This afternoon, continuing south, pass through Mossman and Port Douglas following closely to the coast-line. Finally, following 15 days of incredible sights your tour will finish in Cairns. Your Coach

Experience the superb luxury and the safety of our Denning & Scania coaches which have the following features: rest room, air-conditioning, reclining fabric seats, large panoramic windows, DVD & CD, air Suspension

Luggage Limits and Clothing

Only one medium suitcase 65cm (26 inch) long x 45cm (18 inch) wide x 25cm (10 inch) deep and 15 kgs (33 lbs) in weight per person with a small bag to take on the coach. Luggage limit for some tours is available on request, phone Langley's. **EXCESS LUGGAGE CANNOT BE CARRIED** Our coaches are fitted with overhead racks for your personal effects. Clothing should be casual, with lighter clothing necessary for the tropics and warmer clothes for the southern areas, especially for some nights. Bring swimmers, towel, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sensible walking shoes, warm jacket and an extra supply of all camera needs.

Motels

Your comfort is important so we select the best motels available and all** the rooms have private facilities. Most motels are licensed, centrally located with swimming pools and laundries. **Facilities in remote areas may be less elaborate and may not have private facilities.

Meals

Every morning we start with a full Australian breakfast of fruit juice, cereal or fruit, a cooked dish, toast and coffee and tea. Except for special occasions, lunch is not included as individual preferences vary so much. Dinner is two or three course, some evenings free for dinner of own choice.

Smoking and Alcohol

Government regulations forbid smoking and alcohol consumption in and on tourist coaches, however frequent stops provide the opportunity for those who desire to smoke.

Fares

All coach tour fares in this brochure are guaranteed and not subject to increase, other than any new Government Taxes, air, sea or rail services, over which we have no control! Fares can be found in the fare box for each tour and include accommodation on a twin/double share basis, breakfast and most dinners and all sightseeing, cruises and inspection fees as per itinerary. Overseas departure taxes are included unless stated otherwise but may be subject to change.

Fares Do Not Include

Lunch, morning and afternoon teas and occasional dinners (except where indicated as included on itinerary) and all items of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone calls, drinks and items of an emergency nature.

Single Supplement

A limited number of these are available on most tours.

Travelling Alone

Where a single passenger is willing to share accommodation with a fellow single passenger the company will endeavor to find another of the same gender, however if no suitable companion can be arranged, single supplement must be paid. The Company otherwise accepts no responsibility of the rooming partner and it is a condition of travel that the single passengers willing to share accommodation, accept the rooming partners allocated by the Company. If a passenger at any time during the tour considers the rooming partner to be unsuitable the Company will, subject to availability and at additional cost to the passenger, arrange single accommodation.

Booking Procedure

A deposit is required as indicated on booking. Final payment due one month prior to departure unless indicated on individual itineraries. Please contact us or your travel agent. Travel agents can forward deposits and other payments on your behalf, but are not the Company's agent purpose of receipt of monies. Receipt of deposit and/or payment by the travel agent does not constitute receipt by the Company and the Company is not liable in respect of monies paid to your travel agent, until monies are received by the Company. It is a condition of carriage that a passenger has paid all tour monies prior to the departure date. The Company will not be bound by any representation reported to have been made on their behalf, unless the representation is confirmed by the Company.

Itinerary

The Company reserves the right to alter or change the accommodation, carriers or coaches at any time for any reason. It also has the right to cancel/alter the itinerary and/or tour without notice as may be found necessary for any reason whatsoever including, but not limited to road, weather or traffic conditions, non performance of suppliers, industrial action, operational conditions and requirements. All additional expenses incurred as a result of any delays, cancellations or alterations will be the sole responsibility of the passenger. Whilst the Company will take all reasonable steps to provide an enjoyable tour, the Company accepts no liability for any loss of enjoyment whatsoever and howsoever experience by the passengers.

Minimum Numbers Policy

All tours are subject to minimum numbers for tour to operate.

Coach Seat Rotation

For the enjoyment of all travelers the Company operates a daily seat rotation system which all travelers must participate in as a condition of booking. (On selected tours)

Cancellation Policy

We strongly recommend you to take out travel insurance to protect your tour fare. Cancellation fees will be charged if you have to cancel your booking with us. The following fees below will apply, in addition to any monies already paid on your behalf to our suppliers.
