Day 1: Sunday 8 May 2022

Dubbo ~ Sydney

This morning we depart Dubbo and travel to Sydney. Enjoying overnight accommodation, including dinner at our hotel.

Day 2: Monday 9 May 2022

We leave early this morning – and we hope you've packed your camera, because you won't want to miss capturing all the sensational things you're about to see on this tour. Our team member will help the group through customs and immigration, before everyone boards their flight to paradise! We arrive in the early afternoon, where we will be met by our Pinetree Tours representative. They will transfer us to our accommodation which is nestled in 11 acres of beautifully landscaped sub-tropical gardens. The hotel is situated in a prime location on Queen Elizabeth Avenue, close to many tourist attractions and museums with the Burnt Pine Shopping Area only a 10-minute walk away. Enjoy a welcome Islander fruit cocktail on arrival before checking into your rooms. This evening we venture next door from our accommodation to the Hilli Restaurant and Café. 'Hilli' in the Norfolk language means to relax, chill out and rest. This is exactly the mood the owners and staff of Hillis Restaurant would like you to experience. Our 2 course dinner tonight will showcase fresh local produce from the Island.

Day 3: Tuesday 10 May 2022

We start the day with a full buffet breakfast at the hotel – help yourself to all the dishes, it's a big day today! This morning, you may choose to explore the island yourself (easily achievable from our central hotel!) – or, you might like to jump on the Pinetree Tours Half Day Orientation Tour. The choice is yours! We personally think the tour is a must for every visitor. Visit historic Kingston, Cascade and Longridge, see and hear about the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches and golf course, the renowned Melanesian Chapel, local Government laws and lifestyle. You won't believe how much of the fascinating history has been preserved. Enjoy some incredible views from scenic spots on this full commentary conducted tour – plus, morning tea is included! Lunch today is at your own arrangement – and the afternoon is at your leisure – but don't eat too much, because tonight – we feast! The Island Fish Fry is one of the best events on the tour! Get stuck into a banquet of scrumptious Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and the main event – fresh fried fish, caught by the locals. Save some room for the Island desserts (and tea or coffee) All the while, enjoy some local entertainment, on the exclusive private property 'Orn Daa Cliff' on Norfolk's western coastline. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. The stillness and the stars are there just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788. However, with the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the

horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 4: Wednesday 11 May 2022

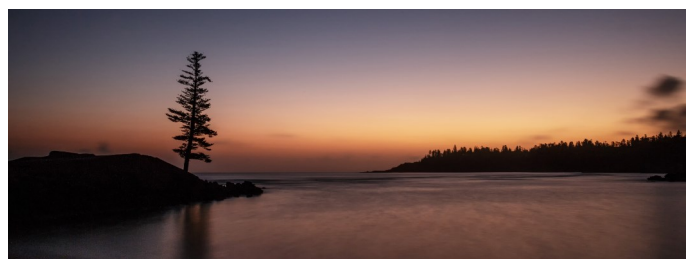
There is no better way to start your day than with the Breakfast Bushwalk and Cliff Top Barbeque. Choose between a stroll through Palm Glen Reserve, or for the more energetic – a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk, have a sleep in and you'll be picked up later and taken to join walkers as they return. Here everyone will enjoy a delicious breakfast barbeque on the clifftop. Talk about a good start to the day! The rest of the morning is at your leisure – and choose from one of the many amazing cafes or restaurants for lunch – if you can fit it in! This afternoon you'll visit Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama – an unforgettable experience. This is one of only a handful of paintings of this type in the world and is based on an art form made popular in the 1800's. Walk inside the circular painting and surround yourself with the immense artwork. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved, with its detailed artwork and realistic perspective and the story that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. This evening, be prepared for yet another sensational meal – with a 3-course progressive dinner, moving around to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night and a great way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes.

Day 5: Thursday 12 May 2022

We begin this morning, of course, with the full buffet breakfast served at your hotel. Then, to get a real insight into the lifestyle on Norfolk Island, you need to meet the people and see the industries in action. On this half day tour, we visit a few of the locally owned businesses that make up their industries. Norfolk Island has a huge amount of small businesses making different local products that we are able to see – and maybe have a taste of! We will also enjoy morning tea at a beautiful scenic location. Lunch and the afternoon is at your own leisure. This evening we enjoy dinner at Governor's Lodge.

Day 6: Friday 13 May 2022 BD
 Norfolk Island

Make sure you hit the full buffet breakfast served at the hotel again– try something different or stick with what you've been enjoying – there's so much to choose from! This morning's tour features some of the Island's loveliest gardens. Visit a nursery owned and operated by a young Norfolk Islander. You will also view the hydroponics! Later, visit a gorgeous private garden with a spectacular view. Morning tea is served at a scenic location. Enjoy the afternoon however you wish– but tonight, don your convict suit (supplied) and enjoy a fun night out. Join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing.

Day 7: Saturday 14 May 2022 BD
 Norfolk Island

This morning is yours for the taking! If you've had your eye on something you wanted to see, let us know and we can make it happen. Or, just lie by the pool and read a book, it's up to you. This afternoon, we start our Indulgence Tour on the south-eastern side of Norfolk Island, at Ball Bay – just another stunning bay with magnificent ocean views! Here you will learn all about how we get fuel ashore, as this is where our supply is unloaded. We then move on to Steeles Point, to enjoy the sheltered valleys behind the coastal cliffs. You may even spot a White Fairy Tern nesting in the forest! From here, we head to the Captain Cook Monument, a scenic lookout where you will stand at the spot on the northern coast where Captain James Cook and his officers landed in 1774. It has some of the best sea views on the Island, with offshore rock formations like Bird Rock and Elephant Rock. We will finish the day the way all fantastic days should end – with wine, cheese & crackers on Mount Pitt. The Lookout gives a 360° view of the whole island, so it will be a picnic to remember!

This evening, you will be taken to a scenic location on the island to enjoy a delicious 2 course BBQ dinner, before our Wonderland by Night event. The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland, lit up like an enchanted forest. Meander along (or ride in the 'moon buggy') a gentle winding path, whilst a descendant of one of the Bounty mutineers recites poetry written by local poet Archie Bigg. The dioramas are lit up and the setting is magical. Afterwards enjoy a light supper.

Day 8: Sunday 15 May 2022 BD
 Norfolk Island

This morning is yours to do with as you please (after your buffet breakfast, of course!) Relax at the resort, or go exploring– our team member can help with some activity suggestions if you're looking for inspiration. Lunch is at your own expense, before

the Convict Settlement Tour in the afternoon! Join us for an in-depth tour of the Georgian Settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones– and hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Walk through the ruins of the new gaol; see the Pier Store, boat shed and the crank mill (afternoon tea is included.) Tonight is murder mystery night, enjoy a three course meal fit for the commandants whilst the mystery unfolds. Meet the Commandant, Clergyman and Convicts of this period, including true characters from the second settlement.



Day 9: Monday 16 May 2022 BD
 Norfolk Island ~ Sydney

Scoop as much as you can on your plate this morning, because it's your final buffet breakfast at the hotel! Pinetree Tours will collect the group and transfer everyone to the Norfolk Island Airport in time for your departure flight this afternoon. We land in Sydney in the early evening. Dinner will be at our accommodation in Sydney tonight.

Your Coach

Experience the superb luxury and the safety of our Austral, Denning & Scania coaches which have the following features: rest room, air-conditioning, reclining fabric seats, large panoramic windows, DVD & CD, air suspension

Coach Seat Rotation

For the enjoyment of all travellers the Company operates a daily seat rotation system which all travellers must participate in as a condition of booking. (On selected tours)

Luggage Limits and Clothing

Only one medium suitcase 65cm (26 inch) long x 45cm (18 inch) wide x 25cm (10 inch) deep and 15 kgs (33 lbs) in weight per person with a small bag to take on the coach. Luggage limit for some tours is available on request, phone Langley's.

Our coaches are fitted with overhead racks for your personal effects. Clothing should be casual, with lighter clothing necessary for the tropics and warmer clothes for the southern areas, especially for some nights. Bring swimmers, towel, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sensible walking shoes, warm jacket and an extra supply of all camera needs.

Motels

Your comfort is important so we select the best motels available and all** the rooms have private facilities. Most motels are licensed, centrally located with swimming pools and laundries. **Facilities in remote areas may be less elaborate and may not have private facilities.

Meals

Every morning we start with a full Australian breakfast of fruit juice, cereal or fruit, a cooked dish, toast and coffee and tea. Except for special occasions, lunch is not included as individual preferences vary so much. Dinner is two or three course, some evenings free for dinner of own choice.

Smoking and Alcohol

Government regulations forbid smoking and alcohol consumption in and on tourist coaches, however frequent stops provide the opportunity for those who desire to smoke.

Fares

All coach tour fares in this brochure are guaranteed and not subject to increase, other than any new Government Taxes, air, sea or rail services, over which we have no control! Fares can be found in the fare box for each tour and include accommodation on a twin/double share basis, breakfast and most dinners and all sightseeing,

cruises and inspection fees as per itinerary. Overseas departure taxes are included unless stated otherwise but may be subject to change.

Fares Do Not Include

Lunch, morning and afternoon teas and occasional dinners (except where indicated as included on itinerary) and all items of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone calls, drinks and items of an emergency nature.

Single Supplement

A limited number of these are available on most tours.

Travelling Alone

Where a single passenger is willing to share accommodation with a fellow single passenger the company will endeavor to find another of the same gender, however if no suitable companion can be arranged, single supplement must be paid. The Company otherwise accepts no responsibility of the rooming partner and it is a condition of travel that the single passengers willing to share accommodation, accept the rooming partners allocated by the Company. If a passenger at any time during the tour considers the rooming partner to be unsuitable the Company will, subject to availability and at additional cost to the passenger, arrange single accommodation.

Booking Procedure

A deposit is required as indicated on booking. Final payment due one month prior to departure unless indicated on individual itineraries. Please contact us or your travel agent. Travel agents can forward deposits and other payments on your behalf, but are not the Company's agent purpose of receipt of monies. Receipt of deposit and/or payment by the travel agent does not constitute receipt by the Company and the Company is not liable in respect of monies paid to your travel agent, until monies are received by the Company. It is a condition of carriage that a passenger has paid all tour monies prior to the departure date. The Company will not be bound by any representation reported to have been made on their behalf, unless the representation is confirmed by the Company.

Itinerary

The Company reserves the right to alter or change the accommodation, carriers or coaches at any time for any reason. It also has the right to cancel/alter the itinerary and/or tour without notice as may be found necessary for any reason whatsoever including, but not limited to road, weather or traffic conditions, non performance of suppliers, industrial action, operational conditions and requirements. All additional expenses incurred as a result of any delays, cancellations or alterations will be the sole responsibility of the passenger. Whilst the Company will take all reasonable steps to provide an enjoyable tour, the Company accepts no liability for any loss of enjoyment whatsoever and howsoever experience by the passengers.

Minimum Numbers Policy

All tours are subject to minimum numbers for tour to operate.

Cancellation Policy

We strongly recommend you to take out travel insurance to protect your tour fare. Cancellation fees will be charged if you have to cancel your booking with us. The following fees below will apply, in addition to any monies already paid on your behalf to our suppliers.
