Day 1: Wednesday 11 September 2024
Dubbo ~ Sydney

This morning we depart Dubbo and travel to Sydney. Once arriving at our accommodation, we enjoy dinner together.

Day 2: Thursday 12 September 2024
Sydney ~ Singapore

Welcome to colourful Singapore! On arrival at Singapore International Airport, a local representative will meet the group and transfer by luxury coach to the Grand Park City Hotel one of Singapore's top notch 5 star hotels located a stone's throw from major shopping malls. This hotel has an old-world charm fused with modern luxuries and features elegant rooms. There is a swimming pool and fitness centre. Wifi is complimentary. Tonight enjoy a welcome dinner at your hotel.

Day 3: Friday 13 September 2024
Singapore Sightseeing Tour ~ Singapore Botanic Gardens ~ National Orchid Garden ~ Bum Boat Ride

Enjoy a delicious breakfast this morning before heading out to explore Singapore on a full day city sights tour. Singapore, officially the Republic of Singapore, is an island country off the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula. Prior to independence in 1965, Singapore was a vibrant trading port. Observe the rich cultural and historical heritage through the sights and sounds of the bustling ethnic enclaves. Along the streets of China Town, Kampong Glam and Little India, religious monuments nestle amidst quaint shop houses. Contrasting with the modern shopping malls, such as the Suntec City, there

D are serene gardens and sleek skyscrapers. The statue of Singapore's founder, Sir Stamford Raffles proudly stands in front of the Victoria Theatre. Its replica stands at North Boat Quay - colloquially known as Raffles Landing Site, as this is the spot where Raffles is believed to have stepped ashore. Stop for lunch today at a local restaurant. On the tour visit the Singapore Botanic Gardens and National Orchid Garden. The Botanic Garden is a 156-year-old tropical garden located at the fringe of the Singapore's main shopping belt. It is one of three gardens, and the only tropical garden, to be honoured as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The National Orchid Garden is located on the highest hill in the Singapore Botanic Gardens. Providing a place for 60,000 orchid plants - consisting of 1000 species and more than 2,000 hybrids - is the three hectares of carefully landscaped slopes. This afternoon we'll hop in one of the bumboats for a cruise along the Singapore River. These hardy little vessels have been in use from the 1600s in Europe although the ones in Singapore have adapted design variations from the original European-style lighters. Commonly known as twakows and tongkangs in Singapore, they were once extensively used for transport purposes along the Singapore River. Returning to the hotel later this afternoon. Dinner is own arrangements.

Day 5: Sunday 15 September 2024

Singapore Flyer ~ Marina Bay Sands

Experience breathtaking, panoramic views on Asia's largest observation wheel – the Singapore Flyer. Enveloped safely in a capsule 165m above ground level, you will be treated to a visual 360° feast of iconic and historical landmarks such as Singapore River, Raffles Place, Merlion Park, and Empress Place. Also, today we'll visit Marina Bay Sands. Drink in the panoramic vistas of stunning Marina Bay, the world-class cityscape, the architectural wonders of Supertree Grove, and the vibrant colours of Gardens by the Bay. From Marina South Pier all the way out to the Singapore Strait, get a bird's eye view of the bustling shipping lanes that have built Singapore's rich multicultural history. Return to the hotel this afternoon for some leisure time and dinner tonight is at a local restaurant.

Day 6: Monday 16 September 2024

Full Day Kranji & Changi Tour with Popiah making

Departing the hotel, today we start the tour at the Kranji War Memorial commemorating heroes lost during World War II. Allow our guide to recount stories of collective spirits that rose through the darkest times of World War II. We continue to drive through the rustic and laid-back Changi Village giving you a chance to see the relaxing side of Singapore and provides a contrast to Tampines New Town, a typical heartland township of present-day Singapore. Today you will see a Popiah (spring roll) making demonstration which combines food with fun, then wrap everything up with a touch of history because deep down, we're all cultured people. Popiah is an iconic Singapore street food that has been a local favourite throughout the generations. Lunch is at a local restaurant today. Continue your tour with a visit to Johore Battery, passing by the remnants of the British Changi Airbase to visit Tampines New Town, a bustling area provides a contrasting environment to the more rustic Changi. Stop

at the housings and retail outlets. Returning to the hotel this afternoon, the evening will be at leisure and dinner tonight is own arrangements.

Day 7: Tuesday 17 September 2024

Half Day Sentosa

After breakfast this morning we'll catch a cable car. Fly high above the hill from Faber Peak Singapore, through a skyscraper and cross the harbour before landing in Sentosa. By Sentosa Station, Tiger Sky Tower has panoramic views that can stretch as far as Indonesia. On the south coast, Palawan Beach is lined with food stalls and bars. You can choose to return to the hotel or spend some more time in Sentosa today exploring the many attractions. Dinner tonight will be at a local restaurant.

Day 8: Wednesday 18 September 2024

Gardens by the Bay

This afternoon we will visit Gardens by the Bay. One of Singapore's premium tourist attractions this man-made garden is not to be missed when visiting Singapore. Garden's by the Bay spans 101 hectares and consists of three waterfront gardens – Bay South Garden, Bay East Garden, and Bay Central Garden. Today we shall visit two of them. You will have ample time to explore the Flower Dome with its stunning floral displays followed by the towering Cloud Forest with its waterfall and suspending walkway in the clouds. Dinner tonight will be at a local restaurant near Gardens by the Bay. Following dinner visit the Supertree Grove where you can see the world from a different perspective on the OBC Skywalk. As night falls, you will be treated to the amazing sound and light show throughout the Supertree Grove – this is one of the highlights of any visit to Singapore. A great way to end your week in Singapore.

Your Coach

Luggage Limits and Clothing

Only one medium suitcase 65cm (26 inch) long x 45cm (18 inch) wide x 25cm (10 inch) deep and 15 kgs (33 lbs) in weight per person with a small bag to take on the coach. Luggage limit for some tours is available on request, phone Langley's.

EXCESS LUGGAGE CANNOT BE CARRIED

Our coaches are fitted with overhead racks for your personal effects. Clothing should be casual, with lighter clothing necessary for the tropics and warmer clothes for the southern areas, especially for some nights. Bring swimmers, towel, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sensible walking shoes, warm jacket and an extra supply of all camera needs.

Motels

Your comfort is important so we select the best motels available and all** the rooms have private facilities. Most motels are licensed, centrally located with swimming pools and laundries. **Facilities in remote areas may be less elaborate and may not have private facilities.

Meals

Every morning we start with a full Australian breakfast of fruit juice, cereal or fruit, a cooked dish, toast and coffee and tea. Except for special occasions, lunch is not included as individual preferences vary so much. Dinner is two or three course, some evenings free for dinner of own choice.

Smoking and Alcohol

Government regulations forbid smoking and alcohol consumption in and on tourist coaches, however frequent stops provide the opportunity for those who desire to smoke.

Fares

All coach tour fares in this brochure are guaranteed and not subject to increase, other than any new Government Taxes, air, sea or rail services, over which we have no control! Fares can be found in the fare box for each tour and include accommodation on a twin/double share basis, breakfast and most dinners and all sightseeing, cruises and inspection fees as per itinerary. Overseas departure taxes are included unless stated otherwise but may be subject to change.

Fares Do Not Include

Lunch, morning and afternoon teas and occasional dinners (except where indicated as included on itinerary) and all items of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone calls, drinks and items of an emergency nature.

Single Supplement

A limited number of these are available on most tours.

Travelling Alone

Booking Procedure

A deposit is required as indicated on booking. Final payment due one month prior to departure unless indicated on individual itineraries. Please contact us or your travel agent. Travel agents can forward deposits and other payments on your behalf, but are not the Company's agent purpose of receipt of monies. Receipt of deposit and/or payment by the travel agent does not constitute receipt by the Company and the Company is not liable in respect of monies paid to your travel agent, until monies are received by the Company. It is a condition of carriage that a passenger has paid all tour monies prior to the departure date. The Company will not be bound by any representation reported to have been made on their behalf, unless the representation is confirmed by the Company.

Itinerary

The Company reserves the right to alter or change the accommodation, carriers or coaches at any time for any reason. It also has the right to cancel/alter the itinerary and/or tour without notice as may be found necessary for any reason whatsoever including, but not limited to road, weather or traffic conditions, non performance of suppliers, industrial action, operational conditions and requirements. All additional expenses incurred as a result of any delays, cancellations or alterations will be the sole responsibility of the passenger. Whilst the Company will take all reasonable steps to provide an enjoyable tour, the Company accepts no liability for any loss of enjoyment whatsoever and howsoever experience by the passengers.
